Carry-on Luggage Ratings

Ratings are based on our Fall 2017 survey from 13,780 CR members' responses to carry-on suitcase satisfaction questions. The Reader Score represents overall satisfaction with the carry-on suitcase and is not exclusively determined by factors under the survey results. A reader score of 100 would mean all respondents are completely satisfied; 80, that respondents are "very satisfied", and 60, that respondents are "somewhat satisfied" on average. Differences of less than 4 points are not meaningful. Each rating category under Survey Results reflects average scores on a scale from "completely dissatisfied" to "completely satisfied." Ratings are based on CR members who may not be representative of the general US population.
